

Here is my contribution to the GSSP collection of lists of things to observe, but it is much more than just a list. At the minimum, each page has either a chart or a photo of the object in question, and many pages have some kind of accompanying dialogue that either tells us something interesting about the object or about another observer's observing report.

The objects that I have chosen are quite varied, and some are only appropriate for large dobs (I have a 25"), but many can be viewed with much smaller instruments. Some are very interesting and some are just pretty.

I have tried to include many objects that most folks have never seen before, objects that need really good charts or photos to identify, objects that aren't really objects at all but simply pretty asterisms, and my favorite category, multiple like or unlike objects in the same field of view.

I also added several pages of objects already on Steve Gottlieb's list because a page for them already existed in my extensive library.
